While covering the topics above you will do some woodturning each week. At the end of this course, you will understand the components of a woodturning lathe and its operation. You will know the various types of woodturning chisels, their application and how to sharpen them. When you have completed the course, you will be able to safely rough down a piece of timber, cut beads and coves, make a bowl, and make a box.
